

# Denim Jeans Pocket Magnets



If you cannot fix those old pair of jeans, why not use the pockets to make a handy fridge magnet to keep notes, vouchers or anything else useful in!

**What You Will Need:** Jeans (which can no longer be fixed or reused), scissors, fabric paint, lace/ribbon trim, fridge magnet (one for each pocket, ) craft/fabric glue and decorations such as ribbon flowers, stick on jewels etc.

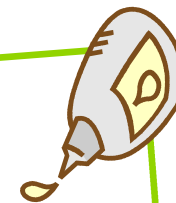
**WARNING:** Due to the use of scissors and glue in this activity, adult supervision is highly recommended.

## Step One

Carefully cut the pockets (front and back) from the jeans.

## Step Two

Glue the desired trim (e.g. lace or ribbon, ) around the top of the pocket. Make sure you start and finish at the back of the pocket, to stop any seams being seen.



## Step Three

Write the desired purpose of the pocket on the front using the fabric paint (following manufacturers directions) such as vouchers, notes or even the name of the person using it, such as Sarah or even Mum or Dad. You could even have one for each person in your home!

## Step Four

Glue or stick on your favourite decorations.

## Step Five:

Glue a magnet to the back of each pocket and stick to your fridge or other magnetic surface!
